Profile Element	Description	
Responsible Entity	The owner of the project	Nebraska Health Information Initiative (NeHII)
Participating Entities	Types of organizations participating, e.g., hospital, provider	Health systems, hospitals, etc.
Description	Short description of the project	The project enables users of the health information exchange to access patient record data directly from their internal EHR software. The user does not need to enter a username or password to access the HIE platform, and they do not need to enter patient demographic information in search fields. That information is securely passed on to the system from the EHR.
Standards Implemented	What standards were implemented in the project	No standards were implemented for this project.
Policies Adopted	What policies were implemented/adopted to support the implementation	No policies were adopted or modified for this project.
Timeframe	Start date, key milestones	The first implementation went “live” in June of 2015.
Volumes	Quantitative indicators, e.g., number of providers, number of records exchanged	Number of users at the facility in June = 741. Number of patients accessed in June by facility users = 5,694.
Impacts	Quantitative results, e.g., reduction in delays, cost savings	No quantitative results have been measured by the facility and communicated to NeHII yet.
	Qualitative results, e.g., provider satisfaction, perceptions, testimonies	Provider satisfaction will be evaluated after the functionality has been in place for 3 months.
